Types of 'Regards'

- Synthesis 'Regards' (R) : *update on a given subject*
- Opinion 'Regards' (RO) : *debates (scientific, research life, teaching, news in environment)*
- Student 'Regards' (RE) : *syntheses, recent results, new ideas by students (Bachelor to PhD)*
